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Overall his knees have been bothering him. His right knee has been having more medial knee pain. He has only been exercising about once a week at the gym. When he does go, he uses the treadmill. He would like to continue his gym membership. His weight he says is about the same.

On examination, right knee medial joint line tenderness was identified. Range of motion of 0-120 motion of both knees is noted. No effusion of either knee could be palpated. No crepitus of either knee.

ASSESSMENT:

- 1. Right knee medial compartment arthritis.
- 2. Left knee status post arthroscopic partial medial meniscectomy.


PLAN: I recommend annual x-rays be obtained to monitor any progressive joint space narrowing. It would be appropriate to take x-rays of both knees on the followup visit. Laboratory studies will be done a week prior to his next office appointment to monitor any renal, hepatic

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or hematologic toxicity to the Celebex as an anti-inflammatory agent which will be continued 200 mg one pill on a once-a-day basis. I have given him a prescription to renew his gym membership. Patient has been permanent and stationary in regards to his industrial injury for many years.
