Dear Kay:

In response to your letter of 6/30/98 regarding meeting scheduling for contract discussions for the General and Supervisors bargaining units, the Board of Trustees is scheduled to meet July 21, 1998. At this meeting, the District's budget is scheduled to be discussed and acted upon. Once the budget is adopted, I will be able to consider a timetable to meet and confer with you. I will contact you on or about July 22, 1998 to schedule meeting dates for contract discussions and other related items.

In response to your letter of June 15, 1998 regarding the still-unanswered issues of your original correspondence of March 12, I am still investigating each item. I hope to respond to some of the issues within the next few weeks. As I stated to you and the employees at the March 25 and May 12 meetings, the District takes these questions and issues seriously, and is committed to some form of resolution of as many of the items as soon as possible.

In regards to my letter of May 12, 1998 to you concerning the proposed District policy changes and employee handbook, I still have not heard from you. The Board of Trustees' Policy Committee cannot constructively perform its function without objective comments from you regarding these documents. I have some available dates between now and the July Board of Trustees meeting to meet with you on this matter if you so desire. As of today, I could meet on 7/6 a.m. or p.m., 7/8 a.m., 7/9 p.m., 7/13 a.m. or p.m., and 7/14 a.m. or p.m. In the event you do not have any comments regarding the proposed policies and handbook, I would only request a simple memo or fax stating so.
