605. The lab contained a five gallon container of waste buffer. In the lab chemical fume hood work area there is a four liter and one liter glass containers of lab waste. The lab technician Shaoming stated that the lab waste is managed as a hazardous waste and brought to the San Joaquin County Hazardous Waste disposal facility. These wastes lacked the required labeling for hazardous waste.

All hazardous waste containers shall be marked with the following information:

- 1. the words "Hazardous Waste"
- name and address of generator
- hazardous properties
- 4. physical state
- 5. composition (contents)
- 6. accumulation start date

Immediately label these containers and ensure that all containers are marked with all the required information. Since it cannot be determined how long the containers of lab waste have been on site, immediately contact a licensed hazardous waste hauler to dispose of this waste under manifest and submit a copy of the manifest to the EHD by 2-13-14.

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

