I am an emotional mess when having to verbally communicate but I am willing to meet with John Stroh, Eddie Lucchesi, Bob Durham, Keith Neinheis and my current boss Brian Heine (who is being used as managements tool to punish me) and you to represent me to make sure before this goes any further all my cards are on the table. .

I have a medical history documented and a calendar of events that lead up to my injury. I feel I have a strong case. I want this worry to stop.

Mary and I both have the same concern but we had 2 different situations that has lead to the same turn. I would like to address some of this separately until the day of the atom bomb, if necessary.
