Dear Judge Crawford:

Defense counsel requests a continuance regarding the upcoming Mandatory Settlement Conference on 2/24/10. The reasoning is as follows:

This case principally revolves around a disputed injury AOE/COE issue. The applicant is currently working full duty and defense counsel understands he obtains medical treatment through his private carrier. Thus, a continuance will not have any direct impact on the applicant's benefits.

By way of history, on 9/8/09, the parties jointly agreed to an OTOC for the purpose of obtaining the AME's deposition both on the issue of causation and the new Almaraz/Guzman issue.

## MEIDINGER, DONALD VS. SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY MVCD

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After coordinating with the applicant's representative, AME Dr. McHenry's deposition was set for 3/25/10. The parties were properly noticed on 10/2/09 (copy enclosed).

Then, possibly through inadvertency, applicant's attorney filed a Declaration of Readiness to Proceed on 11/30/09 on the issue of injury AOE/COE. This was despite the fact that the AME's deposition was scheduled for 3/25/10. The Declaration of Readiness to Proceed cites Dr. McHenry as the evidence the applicant is relying upon. Defendant timely filed an objection to the Declaration of Readiness to Proceed, served on 12/4/09.

In January, defense counsel's appearance was requested in the State of Florida for a Council of Litigation Management seminar from 3/23/10-3/26/10.

Defense counsel requested applicant attorney's professional courtesy for a continuance given that AME Dr. McHenry's deposition was set for 3/25/10. The new deposition date was coordinated with applicant attorney's office and was scheduled for 4/22/10.

WHEREFORE, defendant respectfully requests a continuance of this matter to some date after the AME deposition of 4/22/10. Applicant's attorney has already agreed that the deposition of the AME is necessary pursuant to the joint OTOC on 9/8/09 (copy enclosed). Defense counsel is not available on the following dates:
