John I absolutely decline to authorize my physician to release my personal medical records and I do not authorize my physician to speak to you regarding my medical condition or diagnosis. You are not a doctor nor are any employees or board members that serve the district. HEPA laws provide my right to privacy and I will not release my permission for you to have access to any of my medical records.

All that I agree with is to offer the job description you attached to your letter. I want to document that the first time I ever was given my job description was in 2008 when you sent it to Dr. Murata. From 2004 to 2008 all of my job assignments were given to me verbally by my supervisor. I believe that our current job description is misleading and inaccurate. The job assignments missing are

Catch Basins which require knowledge of all the cities in San Joaquin County, to physically climb out of your vehicle, walk to the designated areas to place chemical in them, climb back inside your vehicle repeatedly at intervals of 4-6 minutes for 4-6 hours. This job is required by all field technicians and lasts up to three weeks for one complete treatment. This process is repeated at least three times a season but last season this job was repeated 5 times due to bad chemical.

Treatment of Cemetery Urns-This job is required by all field
