Subjective: Tiffany noticed pain and swelling on Friday. She called the on-call doctor, Dr. Alegre. She has been using anti-inflammatories. The swelling has improved somewhat, but she has not been working. She was scheduled off yesterday for a funeral.

Objective: On physical examination she has a mild effusion of her knee, she has a mild limp. Range of motion is guarded, from 5-120 degrees.

ASSESSMENT: Aggravation of her knee status post lateral meniscectomy.

PLAN: She will take over-the-counter Motrin, 2400 mg per day, with meals. She will ice her knee at least once-a-day. Hopefully, the knee will settle down by Monday. I plan to have her return to work on that day, 3-30-09. If her knee does not improve next week she will return to the office, and consideration could be made for a repeat MRI.
