Dear Eddie:

I am writing you today to again request documents to which I am entitled and of which you are legally responsible to keep and provide. There are at least five laws and regulations that are applicable to my requests and your company's record-keeping and sharing obligations, 29 CFR 1910.1020. Pursuant to the below, please provide the following:

1. 29 CFR 1910.1048(d) Exposure Monitoring. I hereby request any and all monitoring records for my four exposure episodes, the complete two calendar years of 2004 and 2005.
2. Prop 65. I hereby request written proof of warnings prior to my being exposed to Formalin, formaldehyde products, and all other Prop 65-listed chemicals for the years 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011.
3. California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 8
Sections: 5217: Documentation of the specific actions taken by the District to protect workers like myself from reactions, irritation, and cancer that can result from exposure to formaldehyde;
Section 5194: Documentation that the District told employees, including myself, that they were working in hazardous substances, proof that the District trained employees in their handling, and evidence that the District made MSDS sheets available;
Section 3203: A copy of the Illness and Injury Protection Program (IIPP) that was in place during my active employment with the District for the years 2004-2011;


Section 3204: Copies of my employer-kept medical records as well as records of the District's toxic substance exposure monitoring.

4. I am in need of copies of all four of the Employer First Reports required for my exposures as required and proof that all four were previously provided to the Occupational Health Branch of the California Department of Public Health.

These long-awaited records can be mailed to my address as it appears at the top of the first page. Failing to provide the above-requested documentation will only solidify your violation of the above laws and regulations. If any of the other recipients of this letter wish to discuss or follow-up with me in this matter, then feel free to contact me.

As an aside, I continue to be considered an employee by the District and believe that I have been retaliated against for my Whistleblower activities (California Labor Code Section 1102.5). The District has never fired me but has injured me to such a degree that I cannot return to the job for which I was hired. Thank you.
