In your letter, you mentioned that you may have been retaliated against for your Whistleblower activities. If you have been terminated or feel your employer has otherwise retaliated against you for raising safety concerns, you may contact California's Division of Labor Standards Enforcement (DLSE) to file a whistleblower retaliation claim pursuant to the California Labor Code, Section 6310. DLSE allows employees 180 days to file a complaint after they have learned of the retaliation and/or termination. You may contact DLSE at (916) 263-2991.
