This letter is my first follow-up to your supplemental report dated April 17, 2014. I have had the opportunity to read it over very carefully. In looking at your numbered responses on page 11 of your supplemental report, I am struck by the apparent intellectual incongruity of your response in #4.

How can you possibly both say that all the medical treatment were "appropriate and according to the good standards of medical practice" when you two pages earlier [on page 9], state that Dr. Eck's handwritten notes are "illegible." At the very least, please clarify that you actually cannot include Dr. Eck within the group of treating physicians who provided appropriate treatment for the reason that you cannot make out from his notes just what he did. You would have to exclude Dr. Eck's appropriateness as you wouldn't have a basis upon which to judge his treatment.

I look forward to your response on this specific point. Thank you for your promptest attention to this further request.
