Subjective complaints: Ms. Anderson returns with pain and swelling about her right leg. She has had some improvement with therapy.

Objective findings: On physical examination, she has a slight antalgic gait pattern. She has tenderness and some mild swelling from the midhigh down to the proximal calf. There is tenderness medially, but no tenderness over the lateral joint line. Ligaments are stable. No obvious effusion.

Assessment: Slight improvement of recent right knee strain. She is nontender over the lateral meniscus and therefore should continue with physical therapy. I wrote another prescription for therapy one time per week for four weeks. Follow-up in the office in two weeks. Hopefully, she can return to regular work on May 18, 2009. No light duty is available.
