
Dear Attorney General's Office:

I am writing you today regarding a workplace flyer that I believe to be deceptive and possibly illegal. I've enclosed a copy for your review. It was posted in our break room back in 2009 and also given to each of us employees. We were told by the manager himself that if we had any complaints regarding him, we should just call the phone number. This flyer is clearly not the official Whistleblower Hotline flyer that the state of California produces (also enclosed). The Employee Protection Line® flyer was created and distributed by my employer's risk management provider solely to intercept internal complaints.

I called the phone number listed to complain about the workplace retaliation that I was experiencing from both my manager and the assistant manager. I spoke to an operator who took down my phone number and name. After a day or two I received a phone call from the attorney that represents my employer on a day-to-day basis and in contract negotiations. The attorney interviewed me and said that he would undertake an "investigation." The attorney said that to me over 3 years ago and I have not yet been given his "results."

I would ask you to look into this deceptive workplace posting matter. My intention was to contact the official state site, not my employer's private risk management team. At the very least I'd ask you to contact my employer to have their flyer removed and the official state flyer posted in its place. Thank you.
