Pt denies any fever, No outpatient abx therapy. The redness is worsening therefore pt came to the ER today. Upon arrival pt with htn 228/96 but no symptoms, repeated bp down to 168/80. Pt had h/o right 2nd toe amputation and it is concerned that pt may have Diabetic foot and cellulitis at right leg. Therefore, pt is admitted to hospital for IV abx.

REASON FOR CONSULTATION
Right lower extremity swelling and erythema.

HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS

The patient is a 69-year-old Caucasian female with a history of insulin-dependent diabetes mellitus, hypertension, history of congestive heart failure, history of coronary artery disease and previous coronary artery bypass graft that was done in St. Joseph Hospital about 10 years ago. The patient was in her usual state health when she developed increasing redness and swelling in the lower extremity, above the right ankle. It was localized over the shin area. Denies any trauma. This developed approximately 4-5 days ago. Because of the worsening symptoms, the patient came to the ER and she required admission to the hospital.

PAST MEDICAL HISTORY

Significant for CVA, hypertension, history of diabetes mellitus since just finishing high school, which was more than 30 years ago. History of congestive heart failure. History of hypothyroidism.

PAST SURGICAL HISTORY

History of CABG, appendectomy, and ICD placement. Also history of right second toe amputation because of gangrene.
