Regarding: Surveillance / Sub Rosa evidence and Worker's Compensation

Dear Eddie:

I am writing you today to say that <u>IF</u> you have engaged a firm or firms to observe my movements, then you must limit such surveillance to me alone, immediately. My son was inexplicably followed and photographed yesterday as he left my house; I was not with him.

If my son's harassment arose from a private investigation firm hired by you or your attorneys to track me, then that episode involving my son is beyond what is allowed under the California Civil Code. Sub Rosa is only allowed where an articulable suspicion of fraud or illegal activity can be shown. Again, if this shoddy surveillance of people other than me is coming from you or your attorneys, see the legal limits set out at California Civil Code §1708(g). If District funds are being used for this expense, then I want an itemized accounting as required by law AB1234.
