I am in desperate need of money. I usually pay all my bills early and now for the first time they will be late.

I also considered the idea you stopped sending them to me. This does not make sense since I was not notified.

Please look into this matter and get back to me as soon as you can.

I did leave you a voice mail with my change of phone numbers a few weeks back. I am going to give them to you again just in case you did not get my message.

I will be returning to work on Tuesday May the 26th. My knee is still a bit swollen but my diagnosis has been inconclusive. Dr. Murata is trying to


spare me another surgery. So physical therapy has been his method of choice. It is effective in relieving the swelling. I am glad that I am coinciding physical therapy while I work. I feel safe having someone monitor me while I return to work. Dr. Murata said the last surgery he performed in the same area my tear was took one year to fully heal. It does not get the same amount of blood supply as the rest of the knee, resulting in a longer healing time that other areas of the knee. Upon hearing this it concerned me the first time I returned to work. My job is a very physically demanding one and I did not want to permanently injure myself.

Dr. Murata asked me if I felt ready to return on my last appointment on the 19th. I told him I would like to return, as I am going crazy staying home. I was hoping that I could continue physical therapy for a while to monitor my progress and to check in with someone so I can prevent any further injuries. My knee still hurts a bit and it is still a bit swollen. If I do not heal over time another surgery may be in my future,

Please check on the money and call me o my cell phone. I need to know what is going on. And if it is in your power please allow me to continue PT for a while longer. As of today I have three appointments left.
