NOTICE REGARDING SALARY CONTINUATION DISABILITY BENEFITS

Dear Ms. Anderson:

Acclamation Insurance Management Services Inc. is handling you workers' compensation claim on behalf of San Joaquin County Mosquito Vector Control District. This notice is to advise you of the status of your salary continuation payments.

Payments are beginning and included in your regular paycheck is the sum of \$2668.61 which pays you temporary disability from 06/20/2008 through 07/20/2008.

This benefit is non taxable and is paid to you for every day of a seven day week while you are unable to work because of your injury. The Rate of temporary disability is two thirds of you average weekly wage.

Your benefits rate is \$602.59 per week based on earnings reported by your employer of \$903.88 per week. If this wage information is not correct, please contact me.

Payment will be sent to you every two weeks and will continue until you are able to return to work, your medical condition becomes permanent and stationary, or your eligibility to receive your regular paycheck ends.


Payments are ending because we are now paying Temporary Total Disability.

Benefits paid to you total \$2668.61 from 06/20/2008 through 07/20/2008 at \$602.59 per week.

If you are temporarily disabled beyond your eligibility for continuation of you regular salary; you will be paid temporary disability every two weeks, but will no longer receive the balance of you regular paycheck.

The State of California require that you be given the following information: if you disagree with the decision, you may consult with a State Information and Assistance Officer at 1-800-736-7401 or call your local Information and Assistance Officer at 1-209-948-7650. You may also consult with an attorney. Any person who knowingly presents a false or fraudulent claim for the payment of a loss is guilty of a crime and may be subject to fines and confinement in state prison.
