I am in receipt of your letter dated July 29, 2010. Specifically in your letter you have asked me to look at the QME report from Dr. Tabaddor.


As noted on page 10, Dr. Tabaddor felt Ms. Anderson has work restrictions precluding running, jumping, and prolonged periods of standing, and should be allowed to rest 5 minutes after standing 20-30 minutes.

At the present time I believe Ms. Anderson is able to work without restrictions. I agree with Dr. Tabaddor that she should probably not run or jump, but this is not required of her occupation. I feel, however, that she can perform constant standing without rest.

I have released her to regular work, as she has done very well four months following partial lateral meniscectomy and microfracture of the medial femoral condyle. She was last seen in this office on July 15, 2010, and I felt at that time she was fit to return to full duty.

I have not violated Labor Code Section 139.3, and the contents of the report and bill are true and correct to the best of my knowledge. This statement is made under penalty of perjury in San Joaquin County, CA, dated 8-10-10.
