Date of Exam: September 29, 2011 Part of Body: Right Knee

Subjective: Ms. Anderson has had several episodes of constitutional symptoms after her wound has healed. In fact, she was unable to work yesterday with fever, diarrhea, and considerable weakness. She also noted increased swelling of her knee 2 days ago.

Objective: She appears to be alert and is fully oriented. Right knee moderate tenderness along the medial condyle, medial joint line, superior medial patellofemoral joint. No tenderness over the lateral joint line, no effusion, good range of motion.

ASSESSMENT: Right knee pain, constitutional symptoms which she believes may be related to contamination of her wound. I told Ms. Anderson I have no expertise, as far as parasites or other unusual viral organisms that may have resulted in this type of wound exposure. I therefore am recommending an infectious disease consultation. In the meantime, unless her constitutional symptoms worsen, I suggest she continue modified work: No squatting, walking and standing occasionally, no lifting greater than 20 lb, and no climbing. I don't believe she will aggravate her right knee injury with these work restrictions, and she was reassured. She will follow-up in the office in 2 weeks. Again, I recommend infectious disease consultation.
