Sara and Sheree,

After **re-reading** the Order To Compel Attendance signed by the judge, I did attend the Dr. Tabaddor QME that was set for this afternoon. I decided that I needed to be in complete compliance with the Court's order so I went ahead and attended despite my doubts that had been confirmed by phone calls to Dr. Tabaddor's scheduling department.

Upon contacting the receptionist at this afternoon's appointment, I was told that my appointment had been cancelled. So despite Sara investing all of her time and effort into getting (compelling) me to personally appear today, she failed to keep my appointment open with Dr. Tabaddor.

I could hear Dr. Tabaddor talking to someone in his office but he himself never came out to speak with me. The receptionist (named Katherine?) made it very clear to me that Doctor Tabaddor would not and could not see me today because my medical records had not been pulled in time for this appointment. Again, no effort was made by the compelling party to also convey to Dr. Tabaddor's office that this appointment was being compelled. No one working with Dr. Tabaddor had a copy of that signed order in their scheduling system.

My request to them from earlier this month was to have this QME rescheduled but that has not yet been done. I send you this email now to show my good faith efforts at compliance, especially in light of the Court's order. The receptionist today refused to sign a simple acknowledgment form that I even showed up, so I had to resort to photographic evidence that I was there, on time, today at the designated medical office.
