My personal issues may not be justification for not attending PT, but I am informing you of my circumstances for legal documentation.

My Aunt was hospitalized on Christmas Eve. My aunt has played the role of my grandma. She is widowed, has no children and I am her second durable power of attorney regarding medical treatment. Traditionally my paternal fathers family spent every Christmas Eve at my aunts. My surgery was preformed a week prior to my aunts hospitalization and my immune system was compromised. I was sick for three weeks and contagious. I couldn't even visit her go to the hospital.

My aunt was then sent to a convalescent home for rehabilitation. Released two weeks ago and readmitted to the hospital with a diagnosis of C-diff which is a highly contagious superbug. She is there now and quarantined. I wonder to myself did I transfer this to her during my exposure at work? I'll never know because my complaints were ignored by the my employers medical provider. I had to seek medical treatment from my own doctor and they could not come up with a diagnosis. I was just given antibiotics and my immune system has been compromised since.

My grandma, my mom's mom was sent by ambulance this week admitted and treated for phenomena. My mom is her primary care giver and has COPD herself. I am an only child leaving my mothers care to me.

Today I learned my cousin who is one year younger than me was hospitalized in a comma from a burst aneurysm and died one hour ago.
