Patient returns for evaluation of his knees, particularly the left knee. His knee sometimes acts up. He took a day of sick leave the Friday after his last office visit, and then was better by Monday. He missed about 5 days of work in the past 3 months.

On exam we had difficulty weighing him today. We thought he might weigh 339 lb. The patient did not think he had gained weight, but this represents a 46 lb increase from his last visit. His weight will be repeated at his next visit. Medial joint line tenderness was present bilaterally. It was difficult to assess effusion, due to the size of his legs. No crepitus was noted with range of motion, no ligamentous laxity identified.

ASSESSMENT: Left knee medial compartment osteoarthritis status post arthroscopic partial meniscectomy. Osteoarthritis of right knee, which is not yet a work compensation problem, but he is now filing a claim for this.

The patient's gym membership will be renewed for an additioanl 3 months.
