Regarding: Insurance Fraud by San Joaquin County Mosquito and Vector Control
District (Mosquito District); et. al

Dear Trusted Government Official:

I'd like to know how many knee claims were filed while John Stroh was the manager of the Mosquito District.

I believe that there has been fiscal fraud, self-dealing, and overall financial mismanagement by the Mosquito District from before I began working there in 2004 to the present. Many of their admitted expenditures should raise eyebrows (were the public paying attention). And then there's the unreported amounts that also likely exist. Keep in mind that the Mosquito District is sitting on a roughly 11 million-dollar surplus.

No expense has been spared in making my injuries harder than the reality that I have had 3 knee surgeries and 6 chemical exposures. Everyone involved has made money off of my losses. While I was denied medical attention for the last 5 years unjustly fighting denied claims.

If you have the authority please have all of my medical records provided in full to a QME who is not on their payroll if one exists at all.

Provide an audit of funds paid out in my name during the duration of my 2004-2017 claims handled by AIMS Bickmore Risk Management.

The Mosquito District takes the "special" in special district to new levels of self-importance. In being self-insured, the Mosquito District uses its war chest against all former, injured, and deceased employees.
